#### STAFF CORNER

#### The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

This Sunday we celebrate one of the most profound aspects of our faith. It is also one of the most difficult to understand on an analytical level but at the same time one that the heart can easily grasp.

In trying to explain the Trinity over the centuries, some of our great saints have come up with different analogies to help comprehend how we have Three Persons that are One God. St. Cyril tried to explain the Mystery of the Most Holy Trinity using the sun as an example. He said, "God the Father is that blazing sun. God the Son is its light, and God the Holy Spirit is its heat —but there is only one sun.

Ultimately, while analogies can provide us some ability to visualize the concept of the Trinity, they all fall short. We cannot completely understand God's existence. An infinite God cannot be fully understood in a finite illustration.

But the importance of the doctrine of the Trinity is not in having an intellectual understanding of it, but in entering into the life of the Trinity through baptism and faith.

We may be best talking about the Trinity as something we experience rather than as something we understand. To say we pray "to the Father, through the Son, by the Holy Spirit" tells us more about the Trinity than any analogy ever could.

In a similar way, while we may not be able to fully comprehend this mystery, we can come to understand how the revelation of the Trinity applies to our lives <u>and</u>, in a real sense, how we share in the life of the Trinity.

The Bible tells us that "God is love" (1 John 4:8). Not that He has love, but that He IS love. That is descriptive of who He is and how He lives in eternity, how He interacts with other persons. Even before God created the universe, even before God created angelic beings, He was LOVE. When God was the ONLY thing there was, God was love—love among the triune Persons.

The doctrine of the Trinity tells us that even before God created anything, He could be love, because the Father loved the Son, and the Son loved the Holy Spirit, and the Spirit loves the Father, and so forth. There was love within the Triune God, even before anything had been created (John 17:24). The three Persons were distinct from one another but were united to one another in love.

The wonderful news of the gospel is that God the Father sent His beloved Son into the world to draw us into life within the Trinity.

Just as the Persons in the Trinity interact with one another in love, so we too, as persons, ought to interact with all people in love. Therefore, having been made in the image of God, love should be the basis for our lives and our communities.

The Trinity is one way of saying God is Love.






