

The above quote always makes me think of my dad. He was devoted to St. Therese "The Little Flower." His faith had a very strong influence on my faith. My dad showed me faith in God. He also taught me that the fear of God keeps us from pursuing harmful things. He attended mass daily and if he could not make mass, he always stopped into church to say a quick prayer of gratitude. He always said a rosary while driving and we all would lead a decade when with him. The work ethic he instilled in us was uncompromised and lasted well into his 80's. He had a way of motivating the people around him.

He demonstrated courage in the face of unbelievable adversity. He showed love beyond question. He was totally dedicated to my mother for 54 years, his 3 children, his 8 grandchildren, his parents, his siblings and their children, and all his employees past and present. He was the "Go-to-Guy." If anyone had a problem, was in trouble or in need, he would help - sometimes, in a small way and sometimes in a huge way, always with love. He never expected anything in return and did many things in private, and in secret - things that we his family never knew about. Everything he did was for God. Dad's "reward" was to please God.

On this Father's Day, I am grateful to God the Father for the blessing and example my dad had in my life and still does. My dad has been gone 9 years now. We all think of him and talk about him often. The impact he made in all our lives still lives on. My final words to him were that I loved him and to please continue to watch over us from heaven, and he has!

My dad was a strong man. He was my Hero! He was a man filled with faith. He had a soft heart and calloused hands. He could love, nurture, cook, bake, build, protect, and teach. Whether your dad is here or has passed, it is never too late to say you love him and appreciate him. I am filled with gratitude to our heavenly Father for blessing me with my earthly dad. Remember, sometimes the smallest gesture done in love can have the greatest impact.

Diocese of Albany - Step Up Men's Conference






