It is the Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. Some might think that 13 is an unlucky number, others not so, but if you pay attention to the bible, important numbers are strewn throughout the Good Book, including a very important number that is used this week in the first reading and one used in the second reading. These are just a few of the numbers that are found and their importance in the Bible.

The number 12: In today's First Reading of Kings, Elisha is plowing with 12 yoke of oxen and it also mentions Elijah following the 12<sup>th</sup> yoke of oxen.

The number of Apostles.

When Jesus feeds the 5,000, the apostles pick up 12 baskets of leftovers.

The number 3: Is the number of the Trinity

Peter denies Jesus 3 times

Jesus rose from the dead in 3 days

The number 10: The number of commandments.

The number 40: How many days in Lent.

Jesus was tempted for 40 days.

The Israelites wandered for 40 years.

And finally, the number one, which is used in the Bible denoting unity and uniqueness. One God, one Lord and in the Second Reading from Galatians, the whole law is fulfilled in one statement - *You shall love your neighbor as yourself.*

While numbers can be fun for kids, they are a teaching tool as well. I know when I was a Catechist many years ago, I used numbers while teaching and the kids would also look for me when numbers were mentioned in Church.

As you move along in your spiritual journey, remember that although there are many numbers, that we all believe in one God and that is a number that all of us can get behind.


