## STAFF CORNER

### A Reflection by Terry Kois

In today's Gospel Jesus was praying. When He finished, one of His disciples said, Lord, teach us to pray. Jesus' prayer was the Our Father.

Jesus then continued with a story - suppose one of you has a friend to whom he goes at midnight and says, "Friend, lend me three loaves of bread, for a friend of mine has arrived at my house from a journey and I have nothing to offer him." His friend says in reply from within, "Do not bother me; the door has already been locked and my children and I are already in bed. I cannot get up to give you anything."

Jesus also said - ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks, receives; and the one who seeks, finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened.

Jesus makes it sound easy; ask and you shall receive, seek and you will find, knock and the door will be opened.

Sensible people lock their doors at the end of the day, if not well before. Once the door is locked, do not bother to knock. Come back tomorrow after the sun is up and the coffee is on.

Yet Jesus compares the generosity of God with the person who gets up and out of bed, after locking the door, to assist a friend in need. We all lock our doors at certain points in every relationship: when the demands get too frequent, when we are tired or worn down, when our own cares command our attention, when resources run low, and our hearts seem to run dry. Perhaps we should recheck our open-door policy.

When I pray, I often silently recite the Our Father, the Hail Mary and the Glory Be. I may be praying for someone who died, someone who is sick, I pray during the night when I cannot sleep or while driving, just for the peace of mind I feel while praying. But it is always the same trio of prayers, usually repeated. On the other hand, when I am asking for something such as a quick recovery from a sickness for someone, a quick death with no suffering, or help making a decision, my prayers become a less formal "One on One Talk." Not all my prayers are answered in the manner that I asked. Is it because I am praying for "MY" will and not "THY" will be done?

## CIRCLE OF MERCY BACK TO SCHOOL PROGRAM

Due to the high cost of preparing students for school, Circles of Mercy has a program available where low-income parents may come in and get free school supplies for their high school-aged children. This project is known as "Cate's Kids Back to School Program" and they need your assistance again to help us, help others - especially given the slow recovery from the impact of the COVID-19 virus. Below are the following types of school supplies needed:



Pencils (regular lead #2, color and mechanical ), pencil sharpener, erasers (for pencils), pens (black or blue), markers (dry erase and sharpies - assorted colors), other color markers, pocket folders (assorted colors), glue sticks, scissors, projector/compasses, 3 ring-binders (in 1½", 2" and 3" sizes), loose leaf paper (college ruled), graph paper, spiral subject notebooks (1, 3 and 5 subject in college ruled), subject dividers, plastic zipper pencil cases / boxes, 3"x5" index cards, highlighters (yellow), rulers (regular with metric), kleenex tissues, hand sanitizer (small bottles), Post-It-notes, backpacks (no rollers/wheels), hole reinforcement labels, combination lock (for gym lockers), other electronic items such as: flash drives, ear buds (for computer use) and scientific calculators (TI-84+ Graphing).

We will be accepting donations on the weekends of August 6th & August 7th and again on August 13th and August 14th. There will be collection bins at the entrance of each church. Monetary contributions will also be accepted. A check may be written to Circles of Mercy's for Cate's Kids Back to School Program.


