PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners of St. Mary's and St. John's/St. Joseph's,

REMEMBER, WHEN YOU FORGIVE, YOU HEAL. AND WHEN YOU LET GO, YOU GROW. - UNKNOWN

Isn't that true? I know when I have failed to forgive someone, it eats away at me. The longer I hold onto my lack of forgiveness, the more it really changes who I am. Then I give the person who has hurt me power over me. I become paralyzed and I can't move forward. I am so stuck in the mud, so to speak.

But then I wake up (or the lightbulb goes on) and I realize my lack of forgiveness has done more damage to my being than to the one I have failed to forgive.

So, when I let go of my lack of forgiveness, it is obvious that growth is happening again.

Sometimes, the lack of forgiveness even applies to us. When we can't forgive our own missteps or accept God's forgiveness in the Sacrament of Reconciliation, we also cannot heal and in turn grow once again.

If you are in a state of a lack of forgiveness, let the healing begin with forgiveness and start growing again.
