PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners of St. John's/St. Joseph's and the Church of St. Mary,

It is hard to believe that the Advent Season is once again upon us. The following is from the USCCB (The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops) on what Advent is about. I think this is helpful to remind us of what the season is about and what we are observing.

Beginning the Church's liturgical year, Advent (from, "ad-venire" in Latin or "to come to") is the season encompassing the four Sundays (and weekdays) leading up to the celebration of Christmas.

The Advent season is a time of preparation that directs our hearts and minds to Christ's second coming at the end of time and to the anniversary of Our Lord's birth on Christmas. From the earliest days of the Church, people have been fascinated by Jesus' promise to come back. But the scripture readings during Advent tell us not to waste our time with predictions. Advent is not about speculation. Our Advent readings call us to be alert and ready, not weighted down and distracted by the cares of this world (Lk 21:34-36). Like Lent, the liturgical color for Advent is purple since both are seasons that prepare us for great feast days. Advent also includes an element of penance in the sense of preparing, quieting, and disciplining our hearts for the full joy of Christmas.

The priest wears violet or purple during Advent, except for the Third Sunday of Advent (Gaudete Sunday) when rose may be worn (GIRM, no. 346). Aside from what the priest wears, other aesthetic changes in the Church can include a more modestly decorated altar.

The final days of Advent, from December 17 to December 24, we focus on our preparation for the celebrations of the Nativity of our Lord at Christmas. They are a magnificent theology that uses ancient biblical imagery drawn from the messianic hopes of the Old Testament to proclaim the coming of Christ as the fulfillment not only of Old Testament hopes, but of present ones as well.

Traditionally, Advent wreaths have four candles that represent the four weeks of the season. The subsequent lighting of the candles symbolizes the expectation and hope of our Lord's coming into the world at Christmas, as well as the anticipation of his second coming at the end of time.

<u>Week 1:</u> Purple Advent Candle, Hope, the first candle lit in the first week of Advent is a purple candle, this candle represents hope. In the first week of Advent, we recall the Prophet Isaiah, who anticipated the birth of Jesus. This first candle also represents the anticipation of the arrival of the Messiah.

<u>Week 2:</u> Purple Advent Candle, Faith, the second candle to be lit is also a purple candle. This candle symbolizes faith and the journey of Joseph and Mary to Bethlehem. It calls you out to prepare the way of the Lord.

Week 3: Pink Advent Candle, Joy, the next and third candle to be lit is the pink candle, which represents Joy. This candle reminds us that Jesus' coming is near as we reach the middle point of Advent. The third Sunday of Advent is also called Gaudete Sunday, which symbolizes the nearness of Christ's coming.

<u>Week 4</u>: Purple Advent Candle, Peace, on the fourth and final Sunday of Advent, the last candle is lit, which is purple. This candle represents peace and reminds us of the importance of Peace as the true savior of the world is coming.

I pray that we all have a meaningful and blessed Advent.

LAY TRUSTEE

At the Church of St. Mary, we will be appointing a replacement for one of our two lay trustees who have served the maximum term. Our current Trustees are: Lora Santilli and Jay O'Connor. Lora has now served the maximum term of six one-year terms. Together with the Bishop (President), the Vicar General (Vice President), and the Pastor (Secretary/Treasurer), the two Lay Trustees form the officers of the parish corporation.

The Trustees should function in the same manner as would any Trustee of a not-for-profit charitable or educational organization. They should be knowledgeable of the parish mission and familiar with parish programs. Since their major responsibility is a fiduciary one, they need to be part of the decision-making process and review and sign financial reports sent to the Diocese. It is not mandated but strongly encouraged that the Trustees serve as ex officio members of the pastoral council and finance committee.

An individual must meet the following qualifications to be considered for Trustee:

- Twenty-one years of age.
- A practicing Catholic.

In addition, the following criteria should be weighed when considering an individual for Trustee:

- Active involvement in the parish.
- Business acumen.
- Availability to attend meetings.
- Freedom from any conflict of interest either by occupation or by relationship to the Pastor/Parish Life Director/Administrator.
 Each Trustee will be required to certify annually to the parish corporation that no conflict of interest exists.
- Ability to function on a confidential basis when needed.
- Ability to interact collaboratively with the Pastor/Parish Life Director/Administrator, pastoral council, and any other significant persons or groups in the parish.
- Sensitivity to spiritual and pastoral issues.
