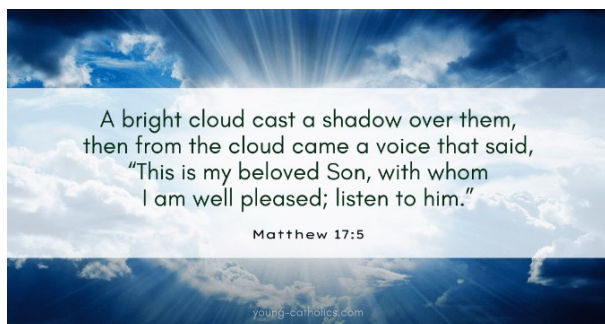

Follow-up and important information for ALL parishioners who attended the AED Training held on Sunday, February 26, 2023:

- Calling 911 from your cell phone does not always go to your local emergency services; dialing 911 from a land-line will. The closest landline in the Church to call 911 or to call Emergency Services is in the Sacristy on the wall behind the door. There is a yellow sticker on all phones with the Emergency Services number. You must dial 9 first to get an outside line.
- Please know that a priest, by Canon Law, must continue a Mass once it has begun, no matter what the circumstance is.



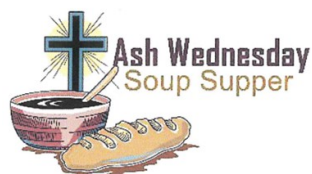

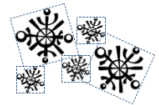
