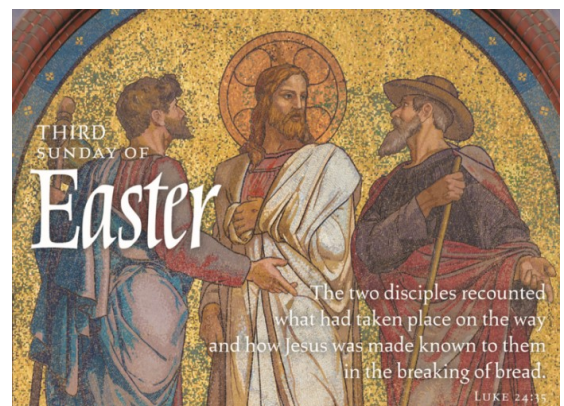

PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners of St. John's St. Joseph's and St. Mary's,

Read the following quote and take a moment to think about it.

“On what does the Christian argument for Immortality really rest? It stands upon the pedestal on which the theologian rests the whole of historical Christianity—the Resurrection of Jesus Christ.”
- Henry Drummond

When I first read it, it didn't really take hold. Then, I read it a second time. Then it got me thinking about our Easter Sunday and the two weeks since then. The first week His disciples found the tomb empty. Last week we had the doubting Thomas. This week is on the Road to Emmaus, where they realize Jesus has Risen!

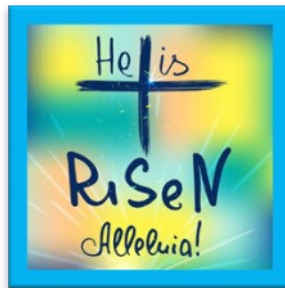
It got me thinking. Would Jesus's birth hold water? Do His early life, His preaching, His passion, His death on the Cross, mean anything?

Jesus's resurrection makes all that proceeded it vital to our faith - how our God broke into our world, through a peasant woman, and how Joseph accepted Jesus as His own and how God influenced Him. Jesus was a carpenter until He was thirty years old, and then He preached for three years, exposing God's wish for humankind. Jesus's resurrection solidified who He was, that God visited us in His son.

Jesus's resurrection made His whole life and what He taught us the center of our faith. Let us focus on His resurrection during this Easter season, but also all that came before it as the center of our faith. With all of Jesus's life and His resurrection, let us keep saying: Alleluia! this means "A Song of Praise to God."

In this time of need, please remember those who don't have enough to eat and drop off food for CoNSERNS-U in the back of Church. Also, personal care items are always in demand.

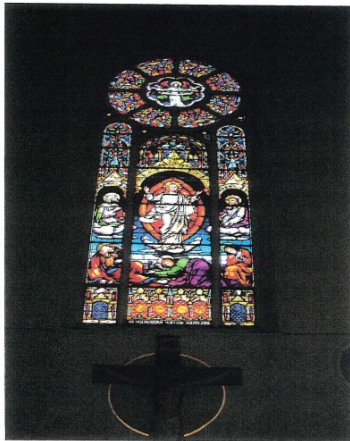
First Friday Adoration

WALKING WITH MOMS IN NEED



What is it?

Walking with Moms in Need is a process through which Catholic parishes and communities "walk in the shoes" of local pregnant and parenting women in need. Our Albany Diocese is currently engaged in supporting this program of the United States Catholic Conference of Bishops (USCCB).

We should all know how to help moms in difficult circumstances. While not trying to turn our parishes into pregnancy centers, we can support local pregnancy centers where they exist, and we can also find and share other resources with pregnant and parenting women.

To this end, the Holy Spirit Respect Life Team, which includes members from all four of our "cluster" parishes, (SJE/SJ, St. Mary's, Holy Spirit and Sacred Heart) has compiled a brochure with a list of resources available in our area that offer help specifically to women in difficult pregnancy situations. This brochure will be available in the narthex of your church. Please pick up a brochure and keep it handy should you meet/know someone who is in need of assistance.

In addition, members of the Respect Life Team of St. John's/St. Joseph's have set up a *Walking with Moms in Need* display in the back of the church. It includes brochures on fertility and infertility, resources to assist pregnant mothers, and on healing after abortion. It also includes prayer cards, rosaries, and "Precious Feet" pins; all for the taking. The display will be up until the end of June 2023. It is a "living" exhibit; meaning that it may be changed and added to over the next several months as specific needs arise. We would like to invite you to come and visit the exhibit and take any literature you find useful. Stop in for a mass!
