PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners of St. John's/St. Joseph's and St. Mary's,

As we celebrate Mother's Day, we celebrate what all our mothers were to us. When my twin and I were eight years old, and my younger brother was six years old, our father passed away two days before Thanksgiving. As I reflect on my mother on this Mother's Day, who passed away in 2009 at ninety-one and a half years old after a battle with Alzheimer's Disease, I am very much aware, in retrospect, of all she sacrificed for all three of us. She was a factory worker at GE in Schenectady for thirty-nine years. My mom took a man's job so she could make more money. When I was a senior in high school, I had to have financial aid papers signed by her. When I went down to GE and I walked into her building, all I saw were men. I was certain I was in the wrong place because there were no women. A man asked me who I was looking for. I said Florence Holmes. He called out her name, saying someone was there looking for her, and she came out of a motor as big as our house with a welding mask on. I was blown away! She never told us what she did; all she told us was that she worked at General Electric in the factory. After that revelation, I had a totally different view of my mom. She made sure we had all that we needed, and although she was a very feminine lady, I had a different view of her and what she did for her three children. She sacrificed so much for us and I am very grateful I had my mom.

So, as we honor our mothers, whether they are alive or have passed away, let us remember all they did for us. I was blessed by my mom, and she taught me what being a Christian is all about throughout her life.

I would also like to take the opportunity at this time to thank all of you who volunteered last weekend for Spring clean-up day. I was very much impressed with the number of people who turned out and the great job you did! Thank you, thank you, thank you! The community of St. Mary's is truly a community of faith.

WALKING WITH MOMS IN NEED

Walking with Moms in Need is a process through which Catholic parishes and communities "walk in the shoes" of local pregnant and parenting women in need. Our Albany Diocese is currently engaged in supporting this program of the United States Catholic Conference of Bishops (USCCB).

We should all know how to help moms in difficult circumstances. While not trying to turn our parishes into pregnancy centers, we can support local pregnancy centers where they exist, and we can also find and share other resources with pregnant and parenting women.

To this end, the Holy Spirit Respect Life Team, which includes members from all four of our "cluster" parishes, (SJE/SJ, St. Mary's, Holy Spirit and Sacred Heart) has compiled a brochure with a list of resources available in our area that offer help specifically to women in difficult pregnancy situations. This brochure will be available in the narthex of your church. Please pick up a brochure and keep it handy should you meet/know someone who is in need of assistance.

In addition, members of the Respect Life Team of St. John's/St. Joseph's have set up a *Walking with Moms in Need* display in the back of the church. It includes brochures on fertility and infertility, resources to assist pregnant mothers, and on healing after abortion. It also includes prayer cards, rosaries, and "Precious Feet" pins; all for the taking. The display will be up until the end of June 2023. It is a "living" exhibit; meaning that it may be changed and added to over the next several months as specific needs arise.
