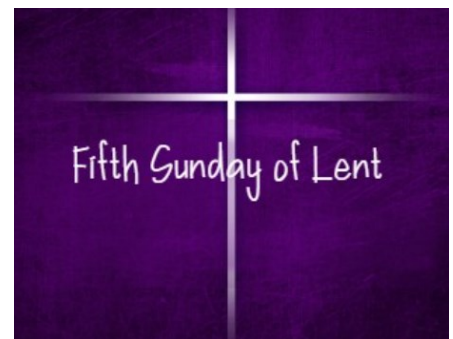

From God's Little Instruction Book, Volumes I, II, III.

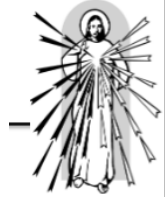
"Life is not a problem to be solved, but a gift to be enjoyed."
