PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners of St. Mary's and St. John's / St. Joseph's,

"The ultimate goal of fasting is to help each one of us to make a complete gift of self to God."

Pope Benedict XVI

I have never thought of fasting in that way. We pick things to give up for Lent usually to benefit ourselves. People give up sweets, people give up ice cream, people give up soda, people give up fat-based foods. I gave up drinking alcohol, (and cigarettes, which I have failed at), and to lose weight (I have lost 12 pounds). But those things are all really to benefit myself. But the one of the three that might be a gift of self to God is the drinking alcohol. It has afforded me to spend more time to think about my relationship with God and Jesus. I like my Scotch. But I have come to realize that my drinking alcohol gets me thinking about many things, but not about God necessarily. I think I have given more of myself to God during this Lenten journey this year because I am giving more thought to my relationship with God.

So, maybe it is a time for all of us to think about what we have given up for Lent and whether it benefits ourselves or if it benefits our relationship with God, and whether it is really a gift of self to God. But that is for each of us to decide. Maybe in the Lents to come we can take this quote by Pope Benedict and apply the whole aspect that fasting is a way to make ourselves a complete gift of self to God. I know that this quote has made me think of my fasting and what really matters in the end.

WALKING WITH MOMS IN NEED



Walking with Moms in Need is a process through which Catholic parishes and communities "walk in the shoes" of local pregnant and parenting women in need. Our Albany Diocese is currently engaged in supporting this program of the United States Catholic Conference of Bishops (USCCB).

We should all know how to help moms in difficult circumstances. While not trying to turn our parishes into pregnancy centers, we can support local pregnancy centers where they exist, and we can also find and share other resources with pregnant and parenting women.

To this end, the Holy Spirit Respect Life Team, which includes members from all four of our "cluster" parishes, (SJE/SJ, St. Mary's, Holy Spirit and Sacred Heart) has compiled a brochure with a list of resources available in our area that offer help specifically to women in difficult pregnancy situations. This brochure will be available in the narthex of your church. Please pick up a brochure and keep it handy should you meet/know someone who is in need of assistance.

In addition, members of the Respect Life Team of St. John's/St. Joseph's have set up a Walking with Moms in Need display in the back of the church. It includes brochures on fertility and infertility, resources to assist pregnant mothers, and on healing after abortion. It also includes prayer cards, rosaries, and "Precious Feet" pins; all for the taking. The display will be up until the end of June 2023. It is a "living" exhibit; meaning that it may be changed and added to over the next several months as specific needs arise. We would like to invite you to come and visit the exhibit and take any literature you find useful. Stop in for a mass!
