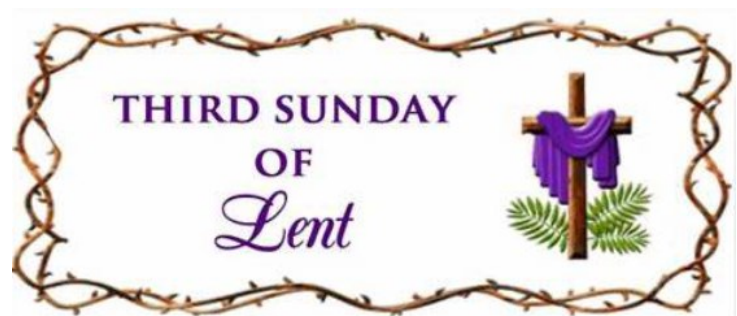

From God's Little Instruction Book, I, II, and III.

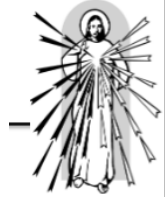
"Sometimes we are so busy adding up our troubles that we forget to count our blessings."

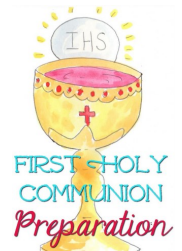

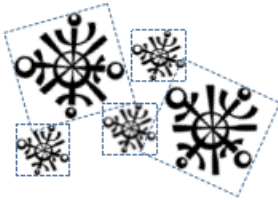
